• No cash nominations accepted. Entries close when numbers of each event have been filled.

• If a Competitor withdraws within 7 days prior to 8am on the first morning of the program the committee is entitled to keep the full amount of the nomination fee, unless extenuating circumstances apply.

• Nomination fees refunded only if competitors or horses are injured and if approved by the Management Committee, accompanied by a vet or medical certificate.

• All Competitors are to be run as per the draw. There will be no changes to the draw unless in extenuating circumstances. No exceptions. Please do not ask as refusal may offend.

• The committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel the program and or event/s in anyway whatsoever and to refuse entries without reason.

• Any competitor who, in the opinion of the Judge, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also from participating in any further events on the program. The Judge's decision in all cases will be final.

• Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint, must lodge the complaint of the incident before leaving the arena. A fee of \$50.00 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$50.00 is forfeited.

• All riders UNDER 18yrs must wear approved skull caps when riding on the grounds, regardless of whether they are competing or not. The chin strap must be securely fastened under the chin.

• No Glass permitted on the grounds.

• All dogs must be on a leash or secured to a vehicle at all times.
