

A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- · Stallions must be restrained as per ACA Rules please read 11.12.
- The status of a horse winning this campdraft will be an Open Horse.
- Any status horse and rider eligible to enter this campdraft
